SFU HAS OFFICIALLY REMOVED THE LANGUAGE 11 REQUIREMENT FOR FALL 2025.

Ensure you review all remaining 11 & 12 requirements for your program

UBC WILL REMOVE THEIRS FOR FALL 2026.

SIAT has added **Math Foundations 12** as an acceptable math. (Pre -Cal 12 is also accepted) <u>School of</u> <u>Interactive Arts and Technology - Undergraduate Admission - Simon Fraser University (sfu.ca)</u>

SFU Beedie has moved Calculus 12 to List B from List A.

Beedie - Your supplemental score plus your academics will determine your rank. **Students should apply in plenty of time** to do a concise job on the supplemental application questions and requirements. Be concise and relevant. Emphasize learning outcomes from your experiences - Leadership, flexibility, communication skills etc. Do not leave it to the last minute! Your 2 referees will answer 3 questions about your specific skills. (short format)

Bachelor of Arts – Performance and Cinema Studies no longer requires a supplemental. (Most other programs still do)
