MINERVA LEARNING TO LEAD PROGRAM

This free leadership program is for female and gender diverse youth in Grades 10–12 to help them explore their leadership potential, build confidence, and create a supportive network for their educational and career journeys. Session dates are Wed, April 9 – 16 – 23 – 30, 6-8 pm, online. One alumna will be awarded a \$1,000 leadership award, one alumna will receive a full scholarship to the Shad Canada Summer Program. Apply now!

CAMP IGNITE

Female students, currently in grades 11-12, will have the chance to explore the many aspects and specialties associated with firefighting. DUE TOMORROW - CHARLES BEST INTERNAL SCHOLARSHIPS

LAST CHANCE - BC TECH SCHOLARSHIPS

Up to 3 x \$2,500 for grade 12 graduates entering a technology-related field of study. See details here. Applicants must show a passion for and involvement in the technology sector, and must have a "B" average. Apply by April 4.

SD43 SCHOLARSHIPS

Reminder: Applications are due Tue, April 15. A variety of different awards are available for graduating SD43 students, ranging from \$500 - \$2,000 – by completing just one online application.

Required: Personal letter, brag sheet or resume. More info here.

CHARLENE REAVELEY BURSARY

This \$1,000 bursary is for graduating students who have lost a parent or a sibling. Must be going into post-secondary and have demonstrated community involvement. Apply here by April 15.

TREVOR LINDEN COMMUNITY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIPS

4 x \$2,500 are available for B.C. student leaders who have made a difference in their school or community by mentoring others, affecting positive change, or initiating community development. <u>Learn more here.</u> **Deadline is April 18.**

BC SCHOOL SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS

BCSS is offering several scholarships to recognize excellence in athletics, leadership, and community service: $2 \times 1,500$ for the top male/ female athletes across the province, 2×750 for the top athlete in each BCSS zone, $6 \times 1,000$ Badminton scholarships, $2 \times 1,000$ based on school spirt & healthy living & community involvement, $6 \times 1,000$ based on leadership values, 2×750 Indigenous Scholarships. Apply here by April 25, 4 pm.

CANADIAN SCHOLARSHIP TRUST BURSARIES

This \$6,000 award (25x) is available to Canadian high school grads (incl. PRs and refugees) whose parents did not attend either college or university. Must have demonstrated financial need.

BC HOUSING BURSARIES

If you are residing in a household receiving subsidy from BC Housing or receiving rental assistance through the Rental Assistance Program (RAP) you are eligible to apply. Awards are \$750 - \$1,000. Apply here by April 30.

PROSPERA EDUCATION GRANTS

15 x \$1,000 and 2 x \$5,000 will be awarded to students entering an accredited post-secondary institution in Greater Vancouver, Fraser Valley, or the Okanagan this Fall. Awards are based on the applicants' positive impact on their communities and other criteria. Apply by April 30.
