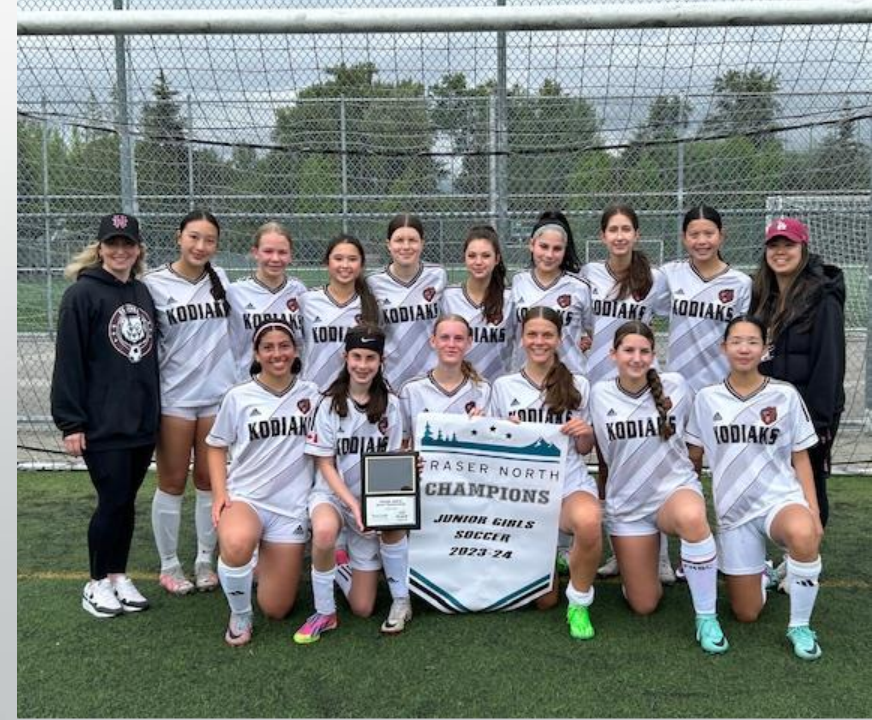

Summer Learning 2024 Volunteer Application Form – SECONDARY STUDENT

This application is due by Friday, May 31, 2024

Students interested in volunteering in the 2024 Summer Learning program are required to complete this application form. High school-aged volunteers will be placed in an elementary or middle classroom at one of our summer sites, July 9 - 26 (Elementary 9am-12pm daily; Middle 8:45am-11:45am daily) for a total of 45 hours. In most cases, only students who can commit to and be available for all instructional days should apply.

All student volunteers are required to submit a "criminal record check for the vulnerable sector" (CRC), **by May 31, 2024**. Get your CRC as soon as possible by taking a print out of this letter to the police station in the city in which you live. If there is a fee charged and you are unable to afford this, please contact Mr. Sawchuk (email address below).
