The tutors will meet online and in person, such as at a public library in your area and charge affordable rates (approximately \$22-25 per hour for high school tutors and \$30-45 per hour for university students). I do not run a tutoring service, but I am happy to connect you with a tutor and for you to work out the details (eg. when and where to meet as well as how often and an agreed upon hourly rate). I know most of the tutors personally through student leadership programs in the Coquitlam School District.

In addition to academic gains, tutoring can also help your child by:

- Improving communication
- Building stronger relationships with peers
- Increasing confidence
- Helping them to reach their full potential
- Increasing study habits, organizational strategies and planning skills

I know of students whose tutor has become a positive role model in their lives and has been connected to them years later.
